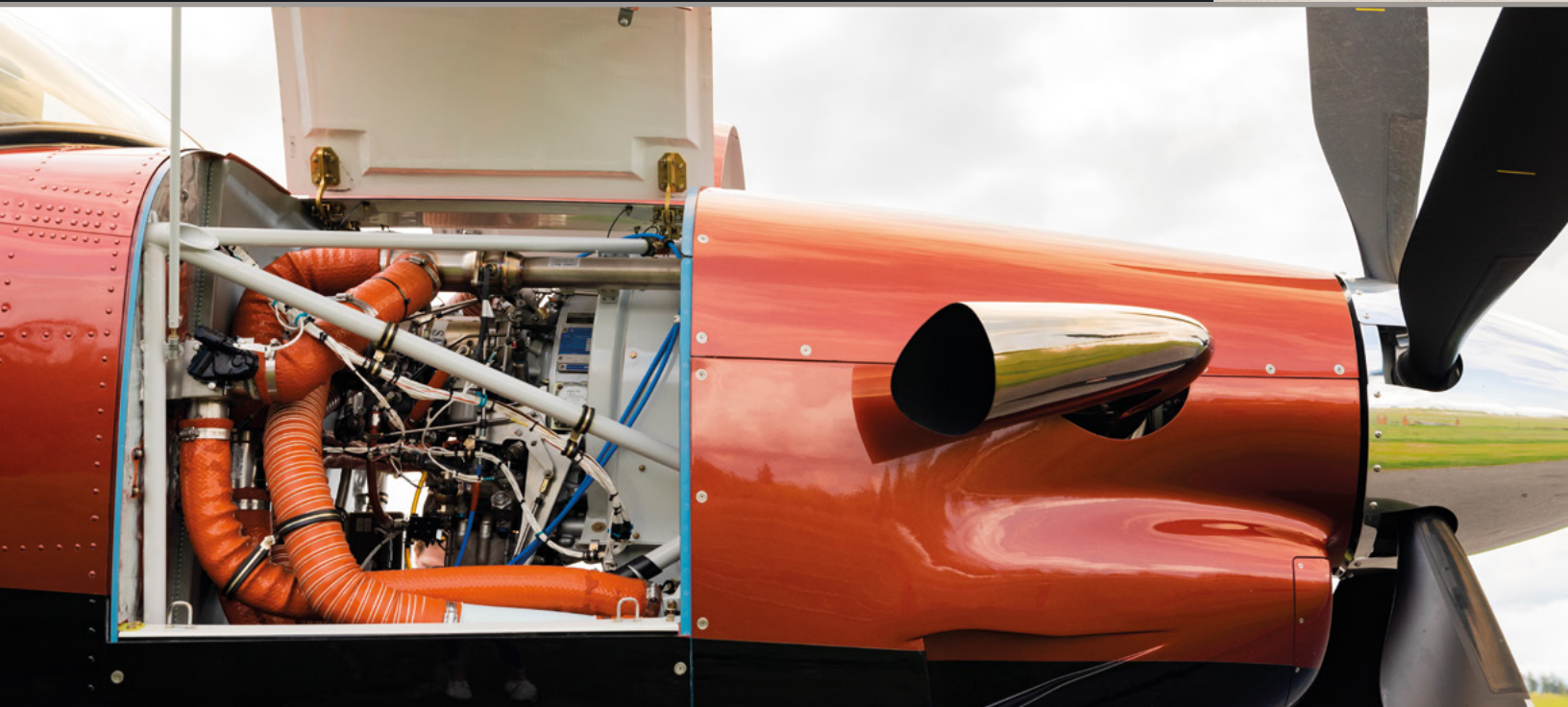
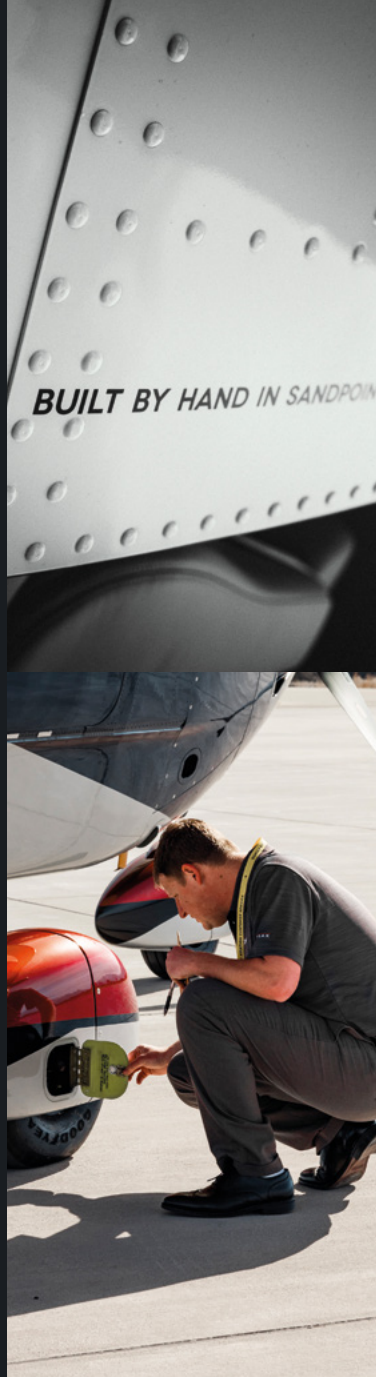

THE 4-YEAR KODIAK MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

With every new Kodiak aircraft, Daher provides the Kodiak Maintenance Program as part of its "Executive" purchase package.

This exclusive coverage offers complimentary scheduled maintenance for the Kodiak's initial retail owner – including annual inspections – during the first 4 years or 1,000 hours of operations for the aircraft, whichever occurs first, consumables excluded.

This program is not transferable and is valid only within the Kodiak Service Center Network.

PRATT & WHITNEY CANADA'S GOLD ESP™ PROGRAM

Pratt & Whitney Canada's Gold ESP™ complimentary subscription covers 400 hours or 2 years, whichever comes first. The applicable hourly rate will be charged after the first 400 hours/2 years. (See Pratt & Whitney Canada's enrollment conditions for details; a value of up to \$70,000).

The ESP™ is a pay-per-hour maintenance program that guarantees long-term engine maintenance costs through a planned and preventative approach to maximize the Kodiak's flying time. It enhances aircraft value by ensuring the PT6A engine is maintained to the highest standards.

EXTENDED ENGINE SUPPORT PROGRAM(OPTIONAL)

For the Kodiak 900, this exclusive package enables the warranty's duration to be extended, as well as extending the PT6A engine's Time Between Overhaul (TBO) by leveraging the power of continuous data-driven support:

- 5-year/2,500-hour extended warranty coverage;
- TBO extension up to 6,000 hours;
- 5-year flight data transmission and analysis services in support of the warranty and the TBO extension.

This package includes the installation of a data transmission unit and the implementation of a comprehensive engine health monitoring plan by Pratt & Whitney Canada or its designated partners.

ME & MY KODIAK APPLICATION

Daher Aircraft introduced the Me & My Kodiak cloud-based application in 2025, building on the experience with its Me & My TBM app – which was launched in 2018 and provides real-time data monitoring, flight tracking, maintenance scheduling and documentation

In the Me & My Kodiak app's introductory version, the Remote Aircraft Status functionality enables “at distance” pre-checks of such aircraft parameters as the quantity of fuel, oxygen and TKS de-icing fluid, along with oil temperature and battery charge.

The app also provides updated documentation based on the owner/pilot's subscription – from Maintenance Manuals, Illustrated Part Catalogs and Line Maintenance Manuals to Service Bulletins, briefing cards, and posters. Additionally, it facilitates the contact with Daher Aircraft's Care teams for customer support.

PILOT TRAINING

At Daher, the priority is to provide owners and operators of TBM and Kodiak aircraft with the knowledge and skills to operate these airplanes at their maximum level of safety. To be fully effective, Daher created the Safe Horizons program that standardizes TBM and Kodiak training across the pilot population.

The first benefit of the Safe Horizons program is the voucher for an initial aircraft and systems familiarization course which comes with the purchase of a new Kodiak.

This course offers the best possible blend of simulator and in-aircraft training.

Comprehensive aircraft and systems familiarization is provided through partner organizations specializing in single-engine turboprop airplanes and STOL flying.

MAINTENANCE TRAINING

The Daher-approved Kodiak Maintenance Training Course is a four-day session that is an available option with the purchase of each new Kodiak. This course takes place at the Kodiak factory in Sandpoint, Idaho, USA, providing trainees with a unique hands-on learning environment that benefits from Daher's production and support expertise across the Kodiak product line.

Customers are provided with the opportunity to send a mechanic of their choice to attend this course. On-site training courses at operators' locations also are available upon request.

In Europe, training is provided by Daher's partner, Air-Formation, in Tarbes, France.

PILOT TRAINING IN THE AMERICAS

In North America, Daher has selected SIMCOM as the factory-approved training organization for the Kodiak 100 and Kodiak 900. Courses take place at SIMCOM's Scottsdale, Arizona training center. A state-of-the-art Advanced Aviation Training Device (AATD) is used to simulate realistic scenarios that may not be safe to fly in an actual airplane.

In addition to the Initial course, training courses for IFR, recurrency, and mentoring also are available. In addition to courses provided for new and current owners/operators, training can be tailored for Kodiak users in the aircraft's multi-role and special mission applications.

5.2

PILOT TRAINING IN EUROPE

For customers outside of the Americas, factory-approved Kodiak flight training is delivered by Classic Air, which is an Approved Training Organization (ATO) in France, certified by the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA).

The training is provided by highly experienced class-rating instructors approved by EASA to deliver a Kodiak SET (Single-Engine Turboprop) Class rating.

THE KODIAK SERVICE CENTER NETWORK

With Daher's global Network of approved Kodiak Service Centers, you never fly alone!

These centers have capabilities that range from inspections to warranty work, as well as upgrades, retrofits, and repairs supported by Daher's factory Design Office.

Increasingly, the Network's Service Centers are dual-approved for the two aircraft in Daher's turboprop-powered product line: Kodiak and the TBM. This provides additional scope and strength across the Daher Network.
